<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Social Harm</b></p> <p>Identify the social harm as included in the definition of the crime. If it is implicit state what the implicit social harm is.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Social harm</b></p> <p>Identify the social harm in the conduct under analysis.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Mens rea</b></p> <p>Identify the mens rea as included in the definition of the crime</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Mental state</b></p> <p>Identify what mental state the perpetrator acted with in the conduct under analysis.</p>	

**Suggested format for the analysis of torts**

<b>Definition of the tort</b>	<b>Facts</b>	<b>Concurrence  (Match)</b>
Write the definition of the relevant tort.	Describe the relevant elements of the conduct under analysis.	
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Act (conduct)</b></p> <p>Identify the act (conduct) as included in the definition of the tort. If it is a negligent tort, think of the due conduct (standard).</p>	Identify the act in the conduct under analysis.	
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Mental state</b></p> <p>Identify the mental element, i.e., whether the tort requires intention or negligence.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Mental state</b></p> <p>Identify what mental state the perpetrator acted with in the conduct under analysis.</p>	
<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Damage</b></p> <p>Identify the damage in the definition of the tort. If it is implicit state what the implicit damage is.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;"><b>Damage</b></p> <p>Identify the damage in the conduct under analysis.</p>
